KEITH SHEPPARD - THE 'SCANDZA' COLLECTION



Keith presents his new body of work, The 'Scandza' Collection which embraces his aesthetic vision and continued development, focusing on a sleek contemporary; 'minimalist' approach to functional and non-functional tableware for modern living.
